

Generating research through partnerships: initial steps

- Define potential research topic, main questions, potential funding opportunity
- Identify potential sites and gauge interest of potential partners
- Assess whether the research would generate meaningful, actionable evidence
- Determine appropriate management structure
- Resource the research project
